16.2.3. Identify and engage with local stakeholders

Identifying and engaging with local stakeholders is crucial for successfully promoting initiatives like equal access to justice, community development, or any other social impact project. Stakeholders are individuals, groups, or organizations that have an interest or involvement in the issue at hand. Engaging them ensures that efforts are aligned with local needs and that they are actively contributing to the desired outcomes.

KARE has implemented a Stakeholder Engagement Policy and procedures to identify local stakeholders. The university, in accordance with its Quality Assurance System, identifies both internal and external stakeholders under the guidance of its Strategic Plan. It reviews and analyses them annually and makes relevant revisions as required. Each year, surveys are administered to internal and external stakeholders to collect their feedback. KARE assesses the involvement of its internal and external stakeholders in university processes annually through the Institutional Internal Evaluation Report.
