
Kalasalingam Medical College and Hospital

Security Office at University Entrance



The university offers a comprehensive security service to ensure the safety and well-being of students, faculty, staff, and visitors.

• Security personnel and CCTV cameras monitor campus areas to maintain a secure environment around the clock (24/7 Surveillance).

- KARE is a gated community with a single entry and exit point manned 24X7 by security guards who are Ex-servicemen.
- A proportional number of lady security guards are also appointed and deputed both in the main gate as well as in the Ladies' hostels.
- CCTV cameras at various locations on the campus, ensure additional safety for the campus inmates.
- Restricted access to certain areas of the campus helps prevent unauthorized entry and ensures safety in academic, residential, and administrative buildings.
- The security team is trained to handle emergencies, such as medical incidents, fire, and other critical situations, with swift response protocols in place.
- Regular patrolling by security officers enhances visible security and deters any potential safety threats.
- For those who need assistance moving across campus during late hours or in isolated areas, the security service often provides escort options.
- Security staff manage the safety of attendees and participants during events such as convocations, cultural programs, and sports events.
- Security personnel help manage parking facilities and control vehicular and pedestrian traffic on campus, ensuring smooth and safe movement.

Research and Development (R&D)

One of the world's best research and development centres, established for accomplishing and exploring innovation in Science and Technology at the university environment.

About 220 faculty members are with PhD qualifications and International research centre established (some major equipment -Scanning Electron Microscope EVO18 (CARL ZEISS), Energy Dispersive X-ray-Spectrometer Quantax 200 with X Flash® 6130, X-ray diffractometer D8 Advance ECO, Fourier Transform Infrared Spectrophotometer IR Tracer 100, Atomic Absorption Spectrophotometer AA 7000)

The institute plays a vital role in promoting the research culture among the faculty members and students in the campus which resulted more than 40 sponsored research projects worth of 14.5 Crore are ongoing from the Funding agencies such as DST, ICMR, DRDO, MSME, ATAL.

Four international research projects in collaboration with Poland, Norway, Malaysia and Thailand.

More than 2500 research findings of our faculty members and students are published in the Scopus indexed journals.

This impacted the strong track record of Kalasalingam in terms of research collaborations, funding, publications and patents and the constant existence of Kalasalingam in the top lists of SIR (SCIMAGO Institutions Ranking).

It has been in the history of Kalasalingam to be recognized and awarded with a unique centre of excellence since the year 2000.


